Parent Instructions

Thank you in advance for helping make Cub Scout Pack 151 such a success! Remember, the money earned from popcorn sales pay for Scout activities throughout the year, as well as helping your scout earn money towards camps and other activities. Please keep this sheet for reference during the sale.

Instructions & Information

Below is important information that you will need to know about the Fundraisers.

1. It is very important to record sales on the appropriate form: Orders taken for delivery later go on the color Trail's End Order Form. Keep track of the Show and Deliver popcorn on the white sheets. Please see below for instructions for ordering popcorn online.
2. If you would like additional Show & Deliver popcorn during the sale, each Tuesday night from 6:30pm to 8:00pm, popcorn and forms will be available for pick-up at **4545 Garden Way North** in Hugo. (Mark Viker's home in Victor Gardens)
3. Payments for popcorn and wreaths can be made by cash or check, however any cash collected will need to be converted into a check when final orders are turned in to the Pack at the end of the sale. Checks should be written to "Pack 151".
4. All order forms and unsold popcorn are due by Oct. 29th. If you do not turn in the popcorn you take for show & deliver, you will be liable for the full value of the product. We will be collecting popcorn and forms at the following locations and times:
 - October 21st (Monday)- 6:30-7:30 Oneka Elementary- Wolf Den Meeting
 - October 24th (Thursday)- 6:30-7:30 Oneka Elementary- Webeloes 1 Den Meeting
 - October 29th (Tuesday)- 6:00-8:00pm Mark Viker's house (4545 Garden Way North.)

Online Order Instructions

Scouts can go to www.trails-end.com and register an account to sell popcorn online. Scouts can use Twitter, Facebook and emails to sell popcorn across the county. No product handling, payments come in automatically. This sale technique is great to use with relatives and friends who cannot easily deliver product to during the fall sale. A great way for older Scouts to earn money using social media and technology! Commission earned will be 35% no matter if you chose the cash option or not. Units will receive credit on their final invoice for commissions due before final payments are due.

Store Front Sales

The Pack has reserved space for Scouts to sell popcorn on several weekends at locations in the area. If you and your Scout are interested in selling in front of a retail establishment, sign up for dates at tonight's kickoff meeting.

1. Each date is limited to 4 total hours at storefronts. Young Scouts recommended only 2 hours working at a time.
2. Scouts working a shift will split the amount of sales for the day with the other scouts working a shift that day. (1 Shift = 1 Share)
3. More information will be provided before the storefront sales begin.

Blitz Contest and other District Prize Ordering

If Scouts achieve the goals for the Blitz weeks (\$250 in sales by Sept. 29th, and/or \$500 in sales by Oct. 6th), the Scout's parents need to go to www.superscoutnaton.com and follow the instructions to register for the Blitz Prizes.

We can not sign your child up for these prizes, the parents have to sign them up through the website.
